The abstract should be single spaced and not longer than one page (about 350 words), using 12 points or larger type. It should have the following format:

Title: Initial capital letters for major words.  
Name(s) of author(s): Surname followed by initials. Identify the presenting author with an asterisk and multiple addresses by numerals in parentheses (1), (2), etc.  
Addresses of authors: The full postal address must be given.
